

Prohibited Medication List

Certain medications are generally prohibited for clients to take routinely due to the potential for abuse, sedation, adulteration of drug tests, or diversion for sequestering illegal substances. Over-the-Counter (OTC) medications may be purchased by Ascension Recovery staff for a specific client if the client has available funds and the medication has been approved by our LIP.

- All Dissolvable Denture Cleaners
- All Erectile Dysfunction medications
- All Muscle Relaxants
- All OTC Medications
- All Phenothiazine derivatives (including promethazine)
- All Scheduled and/or Controlled Medications
- All Sleep Aids
- All Tricyclic Antidepressants
- Anything containing alcohol
- Dextromethorphan
- Diphenhydramine
- Doxylamine
- Efavirenz
- Gabapentin
- Haloperidol
- Mirtazapine
- Oxymetazoline
- Pseudoephedrine
- Quetiapine
- Trazodone

The Prohibited Medication List is subject to change. On intake, unfamiliar or prohibited medications will be researched by staff to determine if it can be dispensed at this facility. If the medication is found to cause false positives or could adversely affect a client's participation in treatment and recovery due to a potential side effect (i.e., sedation), our LIP on staff will determine if a substitute medication is necessary. Any medication that is not allowed to be dispensed in the facility will be stored for 14 days then disposed of properly. The stored medication will be available for pick up during normal business hours.
